1944 Concrete Sealer is designed for extreme toughness, flexibility, and resistance to abrasion, hot water, alcohol, food acids, common solvents and household chemicals and detergents. Formulated for use in high traffic areas of hotels, hospitals, restaurants, schools and industry.

- **1. RECOMMENDED USES:** To be used as a sealer for concrete floors. Excellent as an anti-dust coating directly over new dry (cured) concrete.
- **2. LIMITATIONS:** Do not use over chalk, dust, dirt, grease, mildew, rust, or other improperly prepared surfaces. Apply only when the atmospheric temperature and surface temperature will remain above 50°F. Not recommended for exterior use on continuously exposed surfaces.

- **6. SURFACE PREPARATION:** Surface must be dry and free of chalk, dirt, grease, oil and mildew. Lightly sand all glossy surfaces to provide an anchor profile for the new finish to adhere to.
- **7. MIXING:** One component. Stir thoroughly in a lifting motion before using.
- **8. THINNING:** Mineral spirits or VM&P if necessary.

9. SHELF LIFE: 12 Months

10. CLEAN-UP: Mineral spirits or VM&P.
