

C-1113 DRY FOG

C-1113 Dry Fog is formulated for high speed application and ease of clean-up. Dry fog is designed for economical painting of commercial ceilings & walls, while being able to be swept up without adhering to surfaces after falling a minimum of 8 to 10 feet.

- 1. **RECOMMENDED USES:** For interior use on large wall and ceiling areas, beams, girders, trusses, corrugated metal roof decking, etc.
- 2. LIMITATIONS: Do not paint over chalk, dust, dirt, grease, mildew, rusty, glossy or unsealed surfaces. Apply only when the atmospheric temperature and surface temperature will remain above 500 F. Not to be used on floors. Extended storage of unused material should be avoided. Precautionary
- coverage of machinery is advised to protect moving parts.

- B. Aluminum: #76 Metal Primer.

- D. Wood: 180 Enamel Undercoat

- **6. SURFACE PREPARATION:** Surface must be dry and free of chalk, dirt, grease, oil and mildew. Lightly sand all glossy surfaces to provide an anchor profile for the new paint to adhere to.
- 7. MIXING: One component. Stir thoroughly in a lifting motion before using.

- **THINNING:** Mineral spirits or VM&P Naptha if necessary.
- **SHELF LIFE:** 12 Months
- **10. CLEAN-UP:** Mineral spirits.
